Dear Friends,

I've noticed the night time air is really cool and great for sleeping this time of the year...it's refreshing! Each morning for the past week, I've been reading the "Love Chapter" from 1 Corinthians 13 for my daily devotions... they are comforting, thought provoking... and refreshing too! Here are my favorite verses:

- **1 If I speak in tongues of human beings and of angels but I don't have love, I'm a clanging gong or clashing cymbal. 4 Love is patient, love is kind, it isn't jealous, it doesn't brag, it isn't arrogant, 5 it isn't rude, it doesn't seek its own advantage, it isn't irritable, it doesn't keep a record of complaints, 6 it isn't happy with injustice, but it is happy with the truth.**

These words from Paul to the early Church read like an "instruction manual" for living a meaningful life. ***Patient, kind, isn't jealous, doesn't brag, isn't arrogant or rude, doesn't seek its own advantage, isn't irritable, doesn't keep a record of complaints, isn't happy with injustice, happy with the truth.*** Paul's words fill be with feelings of hope and joy. How about you, when you read Paul's words from I Corinthians Chapter 13 how do they make you feel?

Years ago I was listening to a Christian Radio station and I heard this amazing quote that I've remembered, "***Faith won't change our circumstances, but it will change how we see our circumstances.***" Friends, we all know life is filled with complications and it's far from perfect, yet God promises us that we can find joy in the midst of the difficult experiences of our lives. God promises us if we do our best to faithfully live according to the "instruction manual" in I Corinthians 13, He will give us all we need to face the complications and difficulties with a sense of hope!
